NSE Opens Commo Derivative Delivery Centres in 3 Cities



NEW DELHI NSE on Thursday said it has introduced delivery centres in commodity derivatives segment in three new cities – Mumbai, Chennai and Delhi, effective Jan 25. The move is aimed at facilitating pan-India delivery mechanism, the NSE said. Earlier, as part of the settlement mechanism for bullion contracts, Ahmedabad was treated as the base centre and the main delivery centre. "We are happy to bridge the gap between delivery and the consumption centre and also help facilitate delivery of commodities at different locations with enhanced efficiency with the price, as applicable, pertaining to a particular location," Ravi Varanasi, chief business development officer at the NSE said. –PTI

NSE opens new bullion delivery centres

The National Stock Exchange (NSE) has introduced additional delivery centres in Mumbai, Chennai and Delhi for bullion.

Earlier, as part of the settlement mechanism for bullion contracts, Ahmedabad was treated as the base centre and the primary delivery centre.

Members can express their intentions for accepting and providing delivery at the additional centres by quoting a premium or discount to the basis centre.

Ravi Varanasi, Chief Business Development Officer, National Stock Exchange, said the new delivery centres will bridge the gap between delivery and the consumption centre besides facilitating delivery of commodities at different locations at a price applicable to the particular location.
